

HEADQUARTERS FOR INTERMOUNTAIN RURAL ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION, Sedalia, Colorado — This facility, affording some 58,000 sq ft (5394 m²) of area for offices, a warehouse, and vehicles, is situated in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains. About 450 precast concrete elements (comprising double-tee roof and floor members, columns, and wall panels with exposed architectural finish) were used in the building.

The structure was completed in December, 1980.
