Authors' response

The pull-out values described in "Establishment of Minimum Acceptance Criterion for Strand Bond as Measured by ASTM A1081" apply to ½ in. (13 mm) diameter strand. Values for other strand diameters could be calculated using an equivalent bond stress to the ½ in. diameter strand; however, experimental verification of strand bond for strands larger than ½ in. was beyond the scope of this project.
