

ACI releases new structural concrete specifications



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The American Concrete Institute (ACI) has released two important new documents for concrete industry professionals: ACI 301-16 Specifications for Structural Concrete and the ACI Field Reference Manual.

ACI 301-16 is a reference specification that an architect or engineer can apply to any construction project involving structural concrete by citing it in the project specifications. A mandatory-requirements checklist and an optional-requirements checklist are provided. These checklists assist architects and engineers in supplementing the provisions of this specification by allowing them to designate or specify individual project requirements.

The first five sections of the specifications cover general construction

requirements for cast-in-place structural concrete and slabs on ground. Provisions governing testing, evaluation, and acceptance of concrete as well as acceptance of the structures are included. The remaining sections are devoted to precast structural concrete, precast architectural concrete, posttensioned

concrete, architectural concrete, lightweight concrete, mass concrete, shrinkage-compensating concrete, industrial floor slabs, and tilt-up construction.

"There are several major updates to the 2016 document from the previous version published in 2010, including more contractor-friendly language, removal of default requirements for slump, and provisions on alkali silica reactivity," says Michelle Wilson, chair of ACI Committee 301, Specifications for Structural Concrete. "The specifications have been made clearer for the user by removing wording that is confusing or subject to interpretation."

ACI 301-16 complements the completely reorganized *Building Code Requirements for Structural Concrete* (ACI 318-14) and Commentary (ACI 318R-14). The specifications are inclusive of almost all forms of structural concrete that are used in the building construction industry.

The ACI Field Reference Manual is a compilation of ACI 301-16 and additional ACI documents on measuring, mixing, transporting, and placing concrete; concrete pumping methods; hot- and cold-weather concreting; concrete consolidation; and concrete formwork. ACI 301-16 requires that contractors keep a copy of the ACI Field Reference Manual in the field office of any project where ACI 301 is specified.
