

Journal of Structural Engineering seeks UHPC, high-performance papers

The Journal of Structural Engineering invites abstracts and manuscript submissions for a special collection in the journal on reinforced concrete structures with high- and ultra-high-performance materials. The application of advanced materials for more resilient and sustainable reinforced concrete structures has intensified through research and practice in recent years. The main objectives of this special collection are to highlight some of these recent developments, to allow for comparative studies of such advances, and to document future research needs.

The special collection will contribute to the general mission of the *Journal of Structural Engineering* by focusing on fundamental knowledge that advances the state of the art and state of the practice in structural engineering. In general, manuscripts published in the special collection will reflect original research and technological advances on topics that include but are not limited to the behavior, analysis, testing, design, construction, and regulations of new structures as well as the repair, retrofit, and rehabilitation of existing structures using the following:

- high-performance concrete (HPC), with improved properties and constructability compared with conventional concrete
- ultra-high-performance concrete (UHPC), with superior mechanical and durability properties compared with high-performance concrete
- nontraditional cementitious materials
- high-strength reinforcing bars
- nontraditional metallic or nonmetallic reinforcement

Each manuscript submitted to the special collection will go through the standard American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) peer-review process as it is received and will be published online as soon as it is accepted, regardless of the acceptance status of the other manuscripts submitted to the special collection.

Guest editors are Yahya C. Kurama, professor and associate chair in the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering and Earth Sciences at the University of Notre Dame in Indiana, and Chung-Chan Hung, professor and vice chair in the Department of Civil Engineering at National Cheng Kung University in Tainan City, Taiwan.

Abstracts are due to either guest editor by August 31, 2019, at ykurama@nd.edu or cchung@mail.ncku.edu.tw. Complete manuscripts must be submitted to ASCE through http:// www.editorialmanager.com/jrnsteng/ by January 15, 2020, and should specify that they are being submitted for the special collection on reinforced concrete structures with high- and ultra-high-performance materials. —Source: ASCE
